












General Data Protection Regulation

- 25th of May 2018
- Single set of rules for all EU member states
- Applies to every company dealing with EU-Citizen data
- Accountability for the principles of data protection

- Notified







FERPA


- Define privacy settings for any type of personal data

- Flexible!
















